***Major Duties & Responsibilities***

The Senior Wastewater Engineer (Sr. WWE) position is to perform advanced professional engineering and project management work on a variety of civil, sanitary and environmental projects related to the collection, treatment, and disposal of wastewater. The Sr. WWE also coordinates and oversees the performance of complex engineering tasks by subordinate technical staff within ASPA's Engineering Services and Wastewater Divisions. In addition, the Sr. WWE plans, inspects and administers municipal construction projects and on-going maintenance plans, provides advanced technical engineering expertise and project management skills in planning, design, administration and construction of sanitary sewer systems and all related sewer-line major projects, and assists the ESD manager and Chief Engineer with technical and financial matters as well as other related work delegated by the ESD manager.
