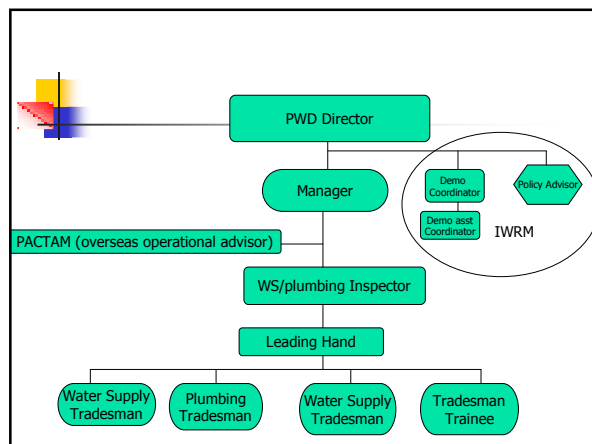

## Department of Works Structure

- Responsible for 5 Divisions,
  - Administration
  - Building and Engineering
  - Civil Construction
  - Mechanical- Heavy Plant & Outside services
  - Water Supply & Sanitation

## Water Supply Structure

- Responsible for water supply network & infrastructure, Ground water monitoring, other water related national and regional programs.
- Water Division currently consist of 6 staff and 1 still on training
- Director of Works also responsible in overall management of Water.
- Other departments, such and Environment and Health also partners in dealing in managing Niue water programs.



## Human Resource Development (HRD)

- *National Training Development Council (NTDC)* responsible for all human resource development for GoN, -council consist Hon Minister, Chair of NPSC, SOG, Chamber of Commerce & Private Sector representatives.
- NTDC role is to *Priorities Training Needs* for both Government and Private Sector also the responsible body for allocation of funding, from donors, namely NZAid, AusAid, GoN and other funding bodies
- Each Government Departments to developed and submit their own HRD to the NTDC through NPSC.
- PWD has submitted a 5 year (2008-2012) HRD for consideration taking to account other HRD from other sectors.

## Public & Education Awareness

- In All national and regional programs (including water) implemented in Niue, *Awareness* component is inclusive.
- Awareness through the primary and secondary schools through their curriculum, annual World Water Day..etc...
- WDM Program has assisted with a proposal for all students to access national water information through **one laptop per child** program (recently launched during the Forum...)
- Awareness through local television & radio programs, local news paper, village Councils
- Awareness in Government sectors through national workshops.

## Private Public Partnership

- Any partnership arrangements has to go through the responsible Department and the National Water Steering Committee (NWSC) to Cabinet
- NWSC consist of various major stakeholders from government and private sector
- NISP is the national overarching plan for Niue that governs all futures economic developments.
